God Auction 2010!

It's almost time to choose our new Patron for 2010-2011! The God Auction is coming on July 11th, and we have four fabulous candidates who want your support: Will Artemis, the Greek huntress extraordinaire, bring us closer to the wild? Will Cai-Shen, the Daoist Treasurer of Heaven, bring us unrivaled prosperity? Will Grandmother Spider, the Navajo patroness of weaving and transformation, tie us closer together? Will Quetzalcoatl, the Mesoamerican winged serpent, bring us a new age of wonder? You will have a chance to help us decide.

Our God Auction is a fund-raiser for Gaia Community and a food-raiser for Harvesters Food Bank. Inspired by Egyptian practice, we will hear the words of the four powers and have an opportunity to support the one(s) we like best by donating food and money. The deity who collects the most support from the community, both members and non-members, will be our new patron and influence our direction over the next year.

To give your support, bring money and/or non-perishable food items on July 11th. Each dollar contributed counts as one point, and each individually labeled food item also counts as one point. The person making the greatest overall contribution in points will receive a lovely basket of gifts from Gaia Community. The most fervent supporters of the individual deities also walk away with thank-you gifts from their deity of choice.

The God Auction is usually our largest and most theatrical ritual all year long, and requires a fair amount of set-up.
